SECRETARY’S REPORT

Motion to accept May’s Minutes, change call to order from Leray to Dan O.

TREASURER’S REPORT

Motion made to accept treasurer’s April report, unanimously. Actions carried from last meeting accepted with changes below.

- a) Taken Care Of - Competitive gym space costs need to be transfer to the Competitive Account.*
- b) All Set Kathy Paid - Outstanding concession stand funds from 2015, Cathy stated that there was \$1300+ outstanding she had a check this week but will wait until next meeting to give to Sherri.*
- c) All Set Kathy Paid \$800 CYSA and Sherri Reimbursed Her -- \$800 to Higher Level training need to take from Competitive funds.*
- d) Resolved - 124 players * 98 = \$12000 total taken in for fees. Outstanding funds being actively worked to make sure everyone paid. Only one child was sponsored.*

DIRECTOR OF REGISTRATION

Leray related Jil’s report - we have 245 kids registered for the Fall. Fees bumped up to normal fee.

DIRECTOR OF COMPETITIVE

Tryouts for the Fall Competitive occurred week of May 23rd, preregistration opened in GotSoccer. 2 Sessions (270+ kids) were held for the competitive. Only 6-8 players could not make tryouts, only one child had not previously evaluated in the U7 age group. Evaluations were completed by a board of people. Jay Knowles organized the tryouts and it was very organized and well done. Plan is to have the A-Team notifications by the end of next week. And start working the B-Teams. Matt seems to think that the girls teams with coaches are all most completed. 4-6 teams are in the SuperLiga playoffs.

Affinity / GotSoccer database discussion, SRI decided to stay with GotSoccer for one more year.

Registration fees set at \$125 competitive fee, uniform fees will be \$70-80. Total fees around \$200 for the Fall season. Players will all be issued new jersey numbers.

DIRECTOR OF COACHES

Karen put the word out for recreational coaches.

DIRECTOR OF REFEREES

19 kids have taken the test, 16 have passed. 25 kids total have expressed interest and 13 kids have been registered for the Fall.

Spring Competitive refs were scarce and filling spots was very difficult but all games were filled. Eric will ensure that one field will be avail for each age group for Sunday and after 1pm on Saturday. U8 will remain 5 v 5 for the Fall 2016, likely to go back to 4 v 4 next spring.

NEW BUSINESS

- Looking to fill the Asst. Competitive Director position. Danielle Buckingham is a willing candidate. She was involved in the PTO at Charlestown Elementary School. She will be considered at the Executive session.
- Scheduled the 3 v 3 tournament for October 15 for Family Day and tournament.
- Considered funding for Kyle Saunders who recently died. Did not decide on whether to make a donation or from where the donation would come.
- Charlie will withdraw \$500 for the scholarship. Sherri will accompany him.
- Charlie suggested making a phone list of board member only.
- AWCT will be the recipient of the 3 v 3 tournament proceeds.
- Boston Breakers have come to CYSA to see if we are interested in joining their scheduled game on Sep. 24th at Harvard University. Need 20 attendees minimum. Erik will follow up on this with a flyer.
- Erik will follow up on CYSA’s status with the SuperLiga and the bond that we paid at the beginning of the season. It involves a single game where both teams did not show for their game when SuperLiga was not notified previously in order to notify the referees. Need to track this in case CYSA is punished for this policy violation.
