SUBJECT: __ARTICLE VI TERRITORIAL LIMITS__ **Current Page #:** _4 of 20__

CURRENT POLICY:

All youths residing within the Chariho area of Charlestown, Richmond, and Hopkinton are eligible to participate within the Association. Any youth residing outside the Chariho area may register to participate in the CYSA Recreational League. A player residing outside the Chariho area may be allowed to participate on a CYSA Competitive Team if there are not enough Chariho players in the respective age group to field a team and said player, 1) registers with CYSA, or 2) provides a SRI Transfer Form and Player ID Number from the Club or Association the player is registered with.

PROPOSED REVISION:

Strike Article VI in its entirety to remove it from the CYSA Constitution.

RATIONALE:

There should be no territorial limits to participating in Chariho Youth Soccer. The CYSA Bylaws contain more info about registration specifics and mandatory registration with Soccer RI, but any youth eligible to play within US Youth Soccer and Soccer RI should be eligible to play for Chariho Rec or Competitive Soccer.
