| CURRENT POLICY: ARTICLE VIII, Section C |
| 1. The presence of nine (9) officers of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum to transact business at the AGM and at the Monthly Membership Meetings. Any business conducted without a quorum can be subject to reconsideration. |
| PROPOSED REVISION: |
| The presence of more than one-half of all Board Members, rounded up, shall constitute a quorum to transact business at the AGM and at the Monthly Membership Meetings. Any business conducted without a quorum can be subject to reconsideration. |
| RATIONALE: A democratic method of establishing a quorum is to have more than half the governing body in attendance, thus establishing a majority of the governing body to transact business. The previous number of 9 did this based upon an 18 member board, but the new language allows the number of positions to change while still establishing the rules to constitute a proper quorum at the AGM and Monthly Membership Meetings. |
